

#### Message from the President

October 2024

We will hold a meeting this month, Wednesday, October 2nd. The meeting starts at 7:30 and will be at La Romeria Park, as always. Bring a model or project for show and tell to share with the other members. Hope to see you at the meeting.

The coastal fog the past few weeks has made it tough to get a glider in the air. Even once the fog

burns off, the lift has been light. I have been flying at the Esplanade in Redondo Beach and Rocky Point. The times I have gone up to Del Cerro I haven't found enough lift or lift out of the correct direction to fly. You need to

be flexible and go when the conditions open up. Even Entradero Park has been tough in the morning, as well when the low cloud deck causes a lot of water to condense on the ground.

I also made the drive down to Bluff Park and flew my Catia and Gentle Lady Mini. It was a Thursday

and no one else was flying. The lift was light, but flyable with the planes I took along. Flying was very relaxed and the flat, green grass made for easy landing. I'll definitely fly there again.

I did attend the Central Coast Airfest at the Santa Maria Airport September 22nd. If you like warbirds, it was the place to be! The focus was World War 2 aircraft. However, several Korean War aircraft were also present. Additionally, a Navy F/A-18 F Super Hornet, an Air Force A-10 and a Marine Corps V-22 Osprey all made demo flights. One advantage to the Santa Maria location is the mild weather compared to Chino. The location and constant procession of aircraft made for a very enjoyable day. I've included a selection of photos from the air show in this newsletter.

This coming Saturday, Planes of Fame will be flying their <u>B-25 Mitchell</u>.
